ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY STATEMENT

Contract Plant will control its business activities to minimise any adverse effects on the environment. Responsibility for safety, health and the environmental matters is ranked equally with that of development, quality of service, sales and financial management.

The objectives of the Policy are:

- 1) To assess in advance the environmental impact of any significant new developments within the business.
- 2) To maintain and operate vehicles and construction equipment in a responsible manner providing the maximum practicable environmental protection.
- 3) To minimise vehicle fuel consumption by applying the most up to date technology and highest levels of service to both our own and customer plant and equipment.
- 4) To encourage the recycling of vehicle components wherever possible – e.g. tyres, oil filters, used lubricants, scrap metal, batteries, body panels etc.
- 5) To minimise the volume of waste sent to landfill using a combination of waste compactors and waste streaming.
- 6) To take steps to reduce water borne pollution by the installation of interceptors and the bunding of all oil storage tanks across all our depots.
- 7) To promote the importance of environmental issues by the provision of environmental training at all levels within the organisation.
- 8) To provide sufficient training and funding to meet its environmental objectives.
- 9) By promoting the sale/hire of electrically powered construction equipment across the industry and hereby accelerating the move away from fossil fuel dependency.
